

Greater Los Angeles HealthCare System (GLA) seeks a General Thoracic Surgeon to work as a VA Physician Thoracic Surgeon. While working at GLA, the incumbent will serve as a staff thoracic surgeon in the section of Thoracic Surgery within the Surgical and Perioperative Careline and will be responsible for the care of thoracic surgical inpatients and outpatients. The surgeon also is responsible for the supervision of cardiothoracic and general surgery residents and medical students in the care of the thoracic surgical patients. In conjunction with the chief of thoracic surgery at GLA, the incumbent is responsible for developing and implementing a research program in thoracic malignancies. The incumbent will participate in a variety of service, care line, institutional, and university affiliate (UCLA) specific meetings. The successful candidate will be scheduled to work part-time 0.625 FTEE (50 Hours Bi-Weekly) within the VA system and the remaining time beyond the 0.625 FTEE will be combined with work in one or a combination of research, intensive care and part-time at UCLA, depending on the candidates experiences and career goals as well as service needs.
