The Heart and Lung Institute at St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center in Phoenix, Arizona is offering a one year non-accredited fellowship in general thoracic surgery and lung transplantation available July 2010. The position will provide training in all aspects of general thoracic surgery including evaluation and surgical management of patients with benign and malignant diseases of the airway, lungs, esophagus and chest wall in addition to minimally invasive techniques, endoscopy, esophageal motility and pH monitoring. The fellow will also receive training in lung transplant donor and recipient selection, organ procurement, implantation and postoperative management. An opportunity also exists to be involved in our basic science and translational clinical program. The ideal candidate has recently completed either the ABTS requirements *or* their equivalent in a thoracic surgery training abroad and desires further training in general thoracic surgery, esophageal surgery, and lung transplantation. Applicants who have completed ABS requirements or their equivalent abroad who desire further general thoracic experience prior to proceeding to cardiothoracic training are also welcome to apply.
