DESTINATION I

Robert Is Here Fruit Stand |Homestead

Challenge: Take a picture with a piece of fruit. **Fun Fact:** A family run exotic fruit stand! Here you can try a variety of tropical fruits, such as the Sugar Apple, Jackfruit, or the Miracle Fruit (it makes everything sweet!) A Key Lime Smoothie for the road is a must! DESTINATION 2

Lake Surprise | Overseas Highway

Jungle Island

Monkey Jungle

Monkey Jungle is a unique eco-show 30-arcre park and discovery center, located in Miami. Jungle wildlife live much as they would in their native habitats. Your Jungle Guides take you deep into the forest for our regularly scheduled Shows and Performances with the Jungle wildlife. Guests explore and experience up close animal encounters with these amazing creatures!



Schnebly Redland's Winery and Miami Brewing Company

Encouraging you to "think beyond the grape" enjoy several wonderful wines made out of tropical fruits, such as avocado, lychee, and passion fruit. Located in Homestead, the tropical gardens, waterfalls, all set a beautiful scene, and located on site, a fantastic brewery that offers craft beer tastings!



Everglades Alligator Farm & Airboat Rides

South Florida's oldest alligator farm, the Everglades Alligator Farm, is located near the entrance of Everglades National Park and contains more than 2,000 alligators. A trip to the Everglades Alligator Farm includes an exciting airboat tour, an alligator show, and an alligator feeding demonstration!



The Turtle Hospital

Located in Marathon Key, guests are invited to take a guided educational tour of the hospital facilities and the sea turtle rehabilitation area.
