The position offers an opportunity to participate in expanding a unique regional thoracic surgery program at one of the most progressive tertiary care centers in the state and region. The candidate will join two other surgeons in the Section of Thoracic Surgery.

Clinical responsibilities will include patient care at OU Health Medical Center and OU Health Stephenson Cancer Center, Oklahoma's only NCI-designated cancer center. Teaching responsibilities will include medical student and resident education at the University of Oklahoma Health Campus.
